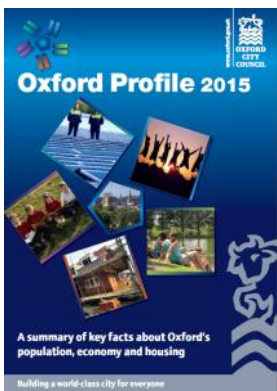


The wheel of work Occupations in Oxford

This chart shows the occupation of people who had their main job in Oxford at the 2011 Census. The number of occupations is less than the total number of jobs because some people have more than one job.

The large number of scientists, health professionals, teachers and lecturers make professional jobs unusually dominant in Oxford. A professional occupation was the main job of 32% of Oxford workers in 2011, nearly double the 17% England average.
