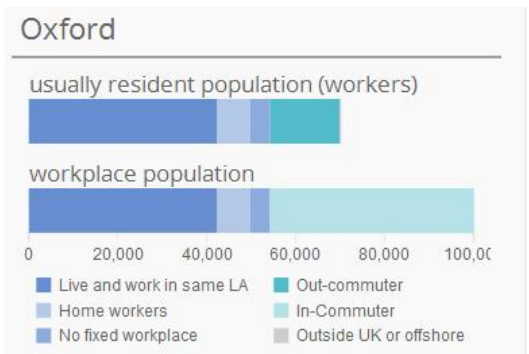


Detailed Census commuting data now released

Data which shows the origins, destinations and methods of travel for commuters has now been released from the 2011 Census. This data shows that Oxford is a major destination for commuters from the surrounding area, which in 2011 meant that its 'workday' population was nearly 30,000 higher than the resident population. The largest inflows and outflows were from and to the neighbouring districts.

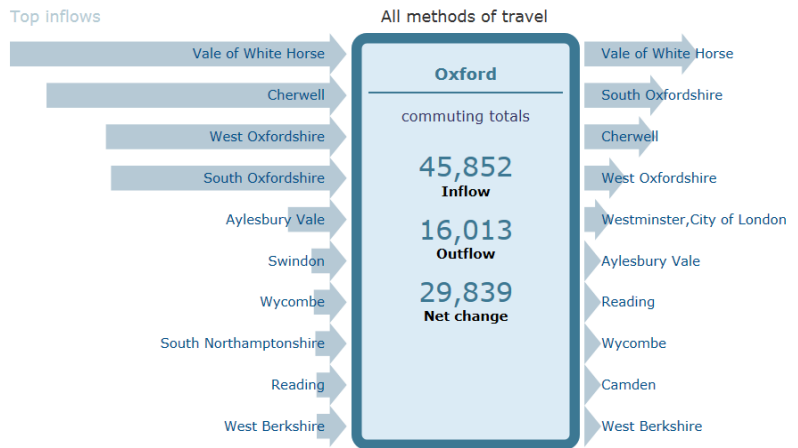
